

## Scripture References – Growing Kid’s God’s Way

### Chapter 15: Discipline Issues (Part Two)

***Psalms 58:3*** The wicked are estranged from the womb; they go astray as soon as they are born, speaking lies.

***Proverbs 6:16-19*** These six things the Lord hates, Yes, seven are an abomination to Him: a proud look, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked plans, feet that are swift in running to evil, a false witness who speaks lies, and one who sows discord among brethren.

***Proverbs 11:1*** Dishonest scales are an abomination to the Lord, but a just weight is His delight.

***Proverbs 12:22*** Lying lips are an abomination to the Lord, but those who deal truthfully are His delight.

***Proverbs 14:25*** A true witness delivers souls, but a deceitful witness speaks lies.

***Proverbs 15:1*** A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.

***Proverbs 15:4*** wholesome tongue is the tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit.

***Proverbs 16:27*** An ungodly man digs up evil, and it is on his lips like a burning fire.

***Proverbs 18:8*** The words of a talebearer are like tasty trifles, and they go down into the inmost body.

***Proverbs 20:10*** Diverse weights and measures, they are both alike, an abomination to the Lord.

***Proverbs 25:28*** Whoever has no rule over his own spirit is like a city broken down, without walls.

***Proverbs 26:4-5*** Do not answer a fool according to his folly, lest you also be like him. Answer a fool according to his folly, lest he be wise in his own eyes.

***Proverbs 26:18-20*** Like a madman shooting firebrands or deadly arrows is a man who deceives his neighbor and says, "I was only joking!" Where there is no wood, the fire goes out; and where there is no talebearer, strife ceases.

***Proverbs 29:11*** A fool vents all his feelings, but a wise man holds them back.

***John 15:13*** Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.

***Romans 12:17*** Repay no one evil for evil. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men.

***Hebrews 10:24*** And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds.

***1 Peter 4:15*** But let none of you suffer as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, or as a busybody in other people's matters.

***1 John 3:10b*** Whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is he who does not love his brother.

***Revelation 12:10*** Then I heard a loud voice in heaven say: "Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Messiah. For the accuser of our brothers and sisters, who accuses them before our God day and night, has been hurled down."
