There is a direct relationship between doing the homework and success in applying the principles. You will need more than just a casual understanding of what you are about to learn. You may be asked to share some of your insights and discussions of the following questions.

Chapter 6 - Character Development: Respect for Authority and Parents

1. a) Read Chapter 6 in your workbook
b) Answer Questions for Review in your workbook
2. Continue having couch time 4-5 times a week.
3. Be prepared to share a couple of examples of blatant offenses against authority you observe during the week at work, while shopping, or while driving down the road.
4. Evaluate with your spouse your own relationship with your parents. Do you honor them out of duty or devotion? Evaluate why, and be prepared to share your thoughts in class.

Chapter 7 - Character Development: Respect for Age

1. a) Read Chapter 7 in your workbook
b) Answer Questions for Review in your workbook
2. Continue having couch time 4-5 times a week.
3. Teach your child to use the "Interrupt Courtesy". Be prepared to share with the class how long it took your child to routinely begin using the "Interrupt Courtesy".
4. Be prepared to share an act of kindness or respect demonstrated by one of your children to an elder without prompting.

Chapter 8 - Character Development: Respect for Peers, Property, and Nature

 - a) Read Chapter 8 in your workbook
 - b) Answer Questions for Review in your workbook
2. Continue having couch time 4-5 times a week.
3. Take your shopping cart back to the front of the store and discuss how it felt to act according to principles instilled in your conscience.
4. Take note of any special courtesies your children show to each other. (e.g. knocking on the door before entering another's room, helping each other, congratulating a sibling if they win a game, etc.)
